Wilbraham seeking proposals for CPA funding

WILBRAHAM - The town of Wilbraham's Community Preservation Committee (CPC) is seeking proposals for projects addressing open space preservation, historic preservation, affordable housing, and recreation for possible funding under the Community Preservation Act for fiscal year 2015, which begins on July 1, 2014.

The application deadline is the close of business on Jan. 30, 2014. Application forms are available at the Town Office

Building in the selectmen's office.

The CPC will hold two public meetings to answer questions from applicants and to receive comments from residents. Attendance is strongly recommended for all applicants, to assure that the requirements of the Community Preservation Act (CPA) are understood and incorporated into applications. The meetings are set for Nov. 14, Dec. 19, and Jan. 23, 2014 at 7 p.m. at the Town Office Building. Dates are subject to change.

Those interested are urged to visit the statewide Community Preservation Coalition's website at communitypreservation.org to review the types of projects being approved across the Commonwealth.

Allocation of CPA receipts must be by recommendation of the town's Community Preservation Committee and approval of Town Meeting.
